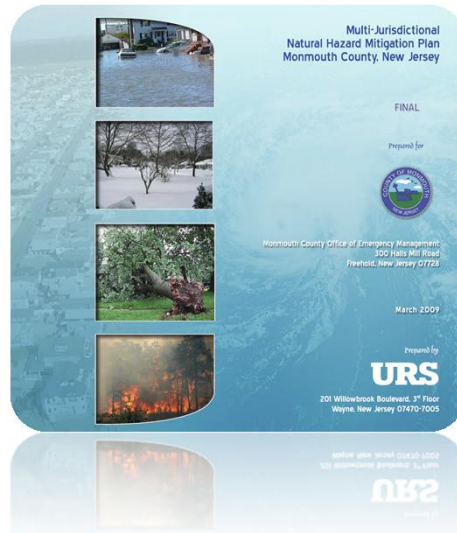

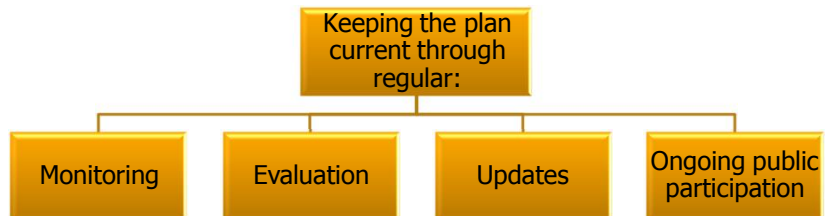

Importance of Regular Plan Maintenance



Monitoring

- Tracking the implementation of the plan over time
- Tracking the status of the identified hazard mitigation actions



Importance of Regular Plan Maintenance



Evaluation

- Assessing the effectiveness of the plan at achieving its stated purpose and goals



Importance of Regular Plan Maintenance

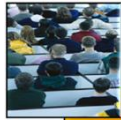


Updates

- Reviewing and revising the plan at least once every five years to make sure that it remains current



Importance of Regular Plan Maintenance



Public Participation in Plan Maintenance

- Continuing to seek public participation after the plan has been approved and during the plan's implementation, monitoring and evaluation.



Annual Plan Evaluation: 2009 Plan Goals



Monitoring

Annual Work Progress Monitoring Reports

- Prepared by each jurisdiction and submitted to MCOEM yearly
- Status of work, any stumbling blocks, etc.
- FEMA How-To #4, Worksheet #1



Annual Plan Evaluation: 2009 Plan Goals



Evaluation

Do the goals and objectives address current and expected conditions?

Has the nature or magnitude of the risks changed?

Are the current resources appropriate for implementing the plan?

Are there any implementation problems (technical, political, legal, financial, etc.)?

Have the outcomes occurred as expected?



Annual Plan Evaluation: 2009 Plan Goals



Evaluation

Have the agencies and other committee partners participated as proposed?

Progress with regard to plan integration

Comments received - public, other stakeholders, etc.

What can be done to bring things back on track?

Updates

County Steering Committee conducts Update Appraisal at Year 3.5

Evaluate the current plan, Annual Progress Reports, and Annual Plan Evaluation Meeting Minutes

Update process to be initiated immediately thereafter



Annual Plan Evaluation: 2009 Plan Goals



Public Participation in Plan Maintenance

Maintain website and document repositories

Link on each jurisdiction web site to mitigation planning page

Annual fact sheet - prepare & distribute

Jurisdictions – annual interviews and/or smaller meetings with civic groups, public, and other stakeholders

Consider annual flyers, newsletters, newspaper articles, radio/tv, etc.
