

Plan Ahead Emergency Pet Kits

- Re-sealable plastic bag: Pet License, microchip, ID, photos of pet with owner(s), proof of up to date vaccinations and name/phone of their veterinarian
- Proper size metal or plastic pet carrier - CRATE
- Leashes and obedience aids, booties to protect feet
- First Aid Kit: cotton bandages, bandage tape and scissors, antibiotic ointment, latex gloves, tweezers, saline solution, and a basic pet first aid book.
- Food: Wet with easy lid (Dry vacuum packed), bowls
- Water in non-breakable containers, 3 days worth
- Medications, with instructions
- Special needs items for exotic pets, such as a heat source
- Newspapers, paper towels, handy-wipes, can openers, a flashlight, blankets, litter

Livestock Kits

- Plastic trash barrel with lid, a water bucket
- Leg wraps, fire-resistant non nylon leads and halters, cotton rope
- First aid items, portable radio and a flashlight with extra batteries
- Generator with a supply of gas
- Sharp knife, wire cutters, tarpaulins, and bleach
- ID packet in a re-sealable plastic bag, including photos from all sides, microchip, tattoo, registration papers, and a record of each animal's age, sex, breed and color. Place duplicates in travel trailer.
- Medical records and medications or special diets, emergency cash
- Transportation
