#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

- A) Community Action Number (CAN) #2 - Develop program to educate residents on severe storms and preparation. Cost estimate \$10,000.00 per year
- B) CAN #3 - Develop maintenance program to clean out streams. Develop mitigation solutions for floodprone roadways. Cost estimate \$50,000.00
- C) CAN #4 - Identify and map areas of potential slope failure. Develop steep slope ordinance. Cost estimate \$10,000.00 per year
- D) CAN #5 - Develop plan for mapping areas of wildfire risk and setting up emergency alerts and fire rescue. Cost estimate \$10,000.00 per year
- E) CAN #6 - Purchase NOAA weather radios for critical facilities. Cost estimate \$1,600.00
- F) CAN #7 - Develop resident education program for winter storm events. Cost estimate \$10,000.00 per year
- G) CAN #9 - Purchase emergency backup generators for pump stations and key traffic signals. Cost estimate \$880,000.00

A) Community Action Number (CAN) 1 - Develop stormwater management plan and regulations/ordinance. The Borough has a stormwater management ordinance that was developed with local funds.
