Jurisdiction: Township of Wall

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#1) Projects Underway or Completed with Mitigation Grant funding - Quarterly Reports on file with NJSP OEM Mitigation Unit: (Brief Project Description)

Action Worksheet #1 - HMPG 4086 Generator, Emergency Power @ Town Hall (w/Library) & Police Department: The design of the project has commenced. A change in scope request was requested and approved to expand the proposed scope at the Town Hall site. Preliminary plans were submitted and approved by the Township Engineer and DPW. Final plans are being prepared for bid.

Action Worksheet #1 - HMPG 4086 Generator, Emergency Power @ Water Pump Stations & Wastewater Pump Stations: The state-local agreement was signed by the State. Investigation, designing and preparation of bid documents commenced.

Action Worksheet #4 - Wreck Pond Flooding: A variety of funding avenues including mitigation funding. State funding, County budget and 4 municipal budgets, private and non-profit organizations.

#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

Action Worksheet #1 - Generator, Emergency Power: Additional funding (\$831,090) to be considered for upgrade and install emergency power to Water Treatment Plants and Wastewater Pump Stations.

Action Worksheet #3 - Desiltation of Shark River Basin: Additional funding to be considered to dredge and pump siltation from the Shark River Basin. Cost unknown

Action Worksheet #4 - Wreck Pond Flooding: Additional funding to be considered to improve the water quality and reduce flooding of adjacent properties. Cost unknown

Action Worksheet #2 - Natural Systems protection; Fuel management (right of way clearing). Cost estimate \$5,000.00 per year for annual removal

Action Worksheet #5 - Protect Structures, elevate and/or acquire floodprone residential structures. Cost unknown.

Regarding Action Worksheet #1 Improvements to prevent flooding were completed at JCP&L's Glendola Substation. Funded by JCPL
