#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

Project 12, design and construction of emergency generators at critical County Highway District facilities is still valid and to be recommended for funding.

Under project 13- Perrineville Dam, Shadow Lake Dam, Indian Dam, Hurley Pond Dam, etc., infrastructure projects are still valid and to be considered for funding. remain to be programmed as funding becomes available. Cost estimates vary.

Under project 14, permanent emergency generator for Monmouth County Human Services Building still valid and to be considered for funding (~\$1,250,000)

Under project 15, Country Bridges and Roadways H-5, H-5A, Palmer Ave (CR7), ML-17, ML-18, ML-19, Station Road, etc. are still valid and to be considered for funding. Cost estimates vary.

Project 16, remove debris and sediment at various locations in an effort to continue infrastructure maintenance and surface water flow is still valid and to be considered for funding. Cost estimates vary.

Projects 17 and 18 are still valid and to be considered for funding.

#3) Projects underway or completed (identified in appendix 1.9, or not) using funding other than Mitigation Grants:(Brief Project Description)

Project 11, design and construction of above ground fuel dispensing facility at Highway District #6 yard is complete and may be removed. County Capital Improvement Budget.

Project 12, design and construction of emergency generators at critical County Highway District facilities will be programmed as funding becomes available.

Under project 13; Lake Lefferts Dam (MA-9) and Matawan Lake Dam (MA-13) are under design contract and anticipate advancement to construction in 2018/19 time frame; and Perrineville Dam (MS-48) is anticipated to be advanced to design in 2017/18 time frame. County and municipal funding.

Under project 14, permanent emergency generator for Monmouth County Hall of Records design is complete and is under construction in 2017. County capital improvement budget. Human Services Building remains to be programmed as funding becomes available.

Under project 15; Country Bridges MA-11 and R-5 are under design and anticipate advancement to construction in 2018/19 time frame; and Palmer Avenue (CR 7) is anticipated to be advanced to design phase in 2017/18 time frame. Other potential projects remain to be programmed as funding becomes available.

Under project 16, County Public Works & Engineering staff has performed activities to remove debris and sediment at various locations in an effort to continue infrastructure maintenance and surface water flow. County staff will continue this effort as situations are identified. County budget.
