#1) Projects Underway or Completed with Mitigation Grant funding - Quarterly Reports on file with NJSP OEM Mitigation Unit: (Brief Project Description)

- 1) HMGP-DR-4086-237R: Install a full building back-up generator at the Police Department. All emergency response agencies are dispatched from this facility. The generator install was complete as of 12/22/2015.
- 2) HMGP-DR-4070: Purchased 4 properties in flood prone areas for Blue Acres. The project was complete as of 9/16/2015.
- 3) HMGP-DR-4086-252: Install a full building back-up generator at the Walnut Street Water Treatment Plant. The generator install was complete as of 6/2016.

#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

- 1) CAN #2 Shelter Hardening: Still valid and to be considered for funding.
- 2) CAN #4 - Protect Critical Facilities: Continue to improve capabilities of EOC (i.e., enhance dispatch communication of EOC as to provide a redundant site for emergency dispatch) \$750,000.
- 3) CAN #5 - Structure & Infrastructure Projects: Power for essential equipment to sustain continuity of operations during loss of power. \$100,000
- 4) CAN #6 Protect Critical Infrastructure/Facilities: Still valid and to be considered for funding.

#3) Projects underway or completed (identified in appendix 1.9, or not) using funding other than Mitigation Grants:(Brief Project Description)

- 1) CAN #1 Education and Awareness: Mass mailing sent with tax bills in 2015 with Municipal budget
- 2) CAN #1 Education and Awareness: Purchased NIXLE Emergency Notification system in 2016 with Municipal budget.
- 3) CAN #4: Protect Critical Facilities: Installed a full building back-up generator at Town Hall (the EOC is located within this facility). Installation was completed as of 11/19/2014 with Municipal budget.
- 4) CAN #5 Structure & Infrastructure Projects: Design phase of installing a generator transfer switch at the Municipal Senior Center which has been identified as a sheltering locations.
