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#1) Projects Underway or Completed with Mitigation Grant funding -Quarterly Reports on file with NJSP OEM Mitigation Unit: (Brief Project Description)

Community action #6 with funding through capital budget and HMPG4086 grant funding. Project is still ongoing with work currently going out to bid for installation of a new emergency generator for the EOC/ police department and dispatch center.

Community action #1 with funding from the capitol budget. Current small generator at EOC/ police department and dispatch center will be relocated to the public works facility that currently has no backup power.

#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

Community action #4, infrastructure project involving drainage improvements of Monroe Ave and adjacent stream cleaning and desnagging. Estimated cost is \$150,000 and the project is dependent on capital budgeting and currently not slated for funding because of its low priority.

Community action #7, elevation and acquisition of flood prone properties, cost unknown.

Community action #5, infrastructure project of roadway stabilization and drainage improvement on Winding Brook Way and Blades Run completed in 2011 using capital budget and DOT grants.
