Jurisdiction: Borough of Highlands
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#1) Projects Underway or Completed with Mitigation Grant funding- Quarterly Reports on file with NJSP OEM Mitigation Unit: (Brief Project Description)

No projects within the Plan have been completed with Mitigation Grant funding as of yet.

#2) Which Projects listed in HMP (appendix 1.9) are still valid and to be considered for funding:

Community Action Number 2 -Infrastructure Improvements and Upgrades: Downtown Stormwater Improvements Project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 3 -Protection of Existing Natural Protective Features and Flood Control Measures: Repairs of troubled areas of bulkheading and mitigation as needed. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 4-- Structure and Infrastructure Projects: Manage development in landslide areas, implement monitoring mechanisms and apply soil stabilization measures as needed. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 5 -Improvements to Electrical and Telecommunication Systems at Critical Facilities to Minimize Future Damage and System Failures: The project will include generators and mitigation measures of various features. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 6 -Implementation of Wind Resistant Building Techniques: Installation of hurricane clips and wind shutters on existing Borough facilities including emergency facilities. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 7 - Protect structures, infrastructure and critical facilities: Conduct a study to determine age and level of protection for each Borough facility for various hazards with a focus on flooding. Then seek mitigation funding for each of those facilities to rectify the deficiencies. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.
Community Action Number 8-- Structure/Infrastructure Projects: Placement of a physical barrier with a moveable flood gate at the mouth of the Shrewsbury River. This would benefit 10 municipalities that border the river and would be a regional project. This project is still valid and to be considered for funding.

#3) Projects underway or completed (identified in appendix 1.9, or not) using funding other than Mitigation Grants:(Brief Project Description)

Community Action Number 1 -Elevation and Floodproofing: More than 50% of the privately owned, flood prone properties within the Borough have been mitigated either through raising, demolition/new construction or floodproofing. These properties have been mitigated utilizing private funds and mainly RREM/HMGP funding sought by the various property owners and not the Borough.
