INMATE LABOR PROGRAMS

In 2014, inmates involved in the Labor Program worked 5,500 hours for 23 different municipalities and non-profit organizations throughout Monmouth County, resulting in an estimated savings of more than \$74,139 for taxpayers. Participation in the Inmate Labor Program is completely voluntary. Inmates enrolled in the program participate in the work projects as an alternative to spending time in jail. Only offenders incarcerated for minor offenses, with records of good behavior, may be enrolled.

Requests for Inmate Labor teams must be made by municipal government officials. Work crews are assigned based upon the scale, and feasibility of the project.

HELPING LOCAL COMMUNITIES GET THE JOB DONE

Budget-crunched municipalities must turn to innovative solutions such as inmate labor in order to maximize the residents' tax dollars. Monmouth County Sheriff Shaun Golden's Inmate Labor program has tackled every type of project imaginable, from painting and rough carpentry, to restoring a Civil War era cemetery.

Inmate laborers involved in the voluntary program have assisted the Public Works department of Millstone, cleaned beach debris after various storms, and restored an historic cemetery in Middletown.
