## ***RAPID RESPONSE***

The Monmouth County Sheriff's Office can respond rapidly in the event that the Project Lifesaver Participant becomes missing. Thousands of rescues have already taken place nationwide with the use of Project Lifesaver. The average rescue time remains under 30 minutes.

### **WHO WILL SUPPLY REPLACEMENT BATTERIES & BRACELETS?**

Personnel from the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office will visit the home to change the battery and replace the bracelet. Most bracelets have a 60 day battery life.

### **WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I COMPLETE THE APPLICATION?**

Your application will be reviewed and if approved you will be contacted to schedule an appointment. A representative will come to your home to explain how Project Lifesaver operates, the equipment used and procedures to be followed. The representative will also install the Project Lifesaver transmitter on the client.

### **WHAT IF A PARTICIPANT GOES MISSING?**

1. Call 9-1-1 and report that a person on the Project Lifesaver Program is missing.
2. Inform the dispatcher that the missing person is on the Project Lifesaver Program with the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office and request that they notify the Monmouth County Sheriff's Office immediately.
3. Assist the sheriff's officers responding with as much information as you can.
