

The convention calls for frequency lists to show four digits after the decimal place, followed by either an "N" or a "W", depending on whether the frequency is narrow or wide band. Mode refers to either "A" or "D" indicating analog or digital (e.g. Project 25) or "M" indicating mixed mode. All channels are shown as if programmed in a control station, mobile or portable radio. Repeater and base stations must be programmed with the Rx and Tx reversed.

Medical Ambulance Buses (MAB)

- MAB-2: Shark River Hills First Aid Squad
- MAB-6: Keyport First Aid Squad & Atlantic Highlands First Aid Squad

Multi-purpose unit utilized to rapidly set up incident rehabilitation, or to provide mass casualty transport of up to 20 victims at a time, or to provide medical facility evacuations. Can move 20 supine victims, or 24 seated, in addition to 15 in wheelchairs, depending on the incident.

MONMOUTH COUNTY EMS RESOURCES

Mass Casualty Response Unit (MCRU)

Response vehicle equipped to provide medical supplies for approximately 150 BLS patients. Additional equipment is carried to support a mass trauma event such as an active shooter. Similar units with ALS capabilities are available from neighboring counties.



MONMOUTH COUNTY EMS RESOURCES

Mass Casualty Response Trucks (MCRT)

- Atlantic Highlands

The two Monmouth County MCRTs carry bulk EMS supplies, including 25 “D” oxygen cylinders, multitors, patient moving devices, BLS jump kits, blankets, collars, splint kits, ICS vests, body bags, PPE, bandages, tarps, trauma bags, cones, and other equipment necessary to supply EMS for a mass casualty incident or scheduled special event.



MONMOUTH COUNTY EMS RESOURCES

ASAP Ambulance

Off-road, fully enclosed, climate-controlled, mini ambulance. Excellent for event coverage, response into crowded situations, or operating in difficult terrain. Capable of transporting two supine patients.

Several EMS agencies also maintain EMS ATV Units that are available in various regions of the County.

Gatekeeper System

The Gatekeeper is a field hospital system which can be utilized for patient surge situations, planned events, and large-scale disaster response.

The SOV is a mass care support unit that can provide bulk oxygen, command facilities, lighting, mass casualty response equipment, and general support for long term incidents. It carries bulk oxygen supplies, tents, HVAC system, and a Gator® Patient Transport ATV.
